## How First McKinney Is Keeping You Safe

We have a phased plan to return activity to our campus. Our goal is to provide a sanitized and safe place for you and your family as we reopen. Here are some of the steps we are taking to keep you safe as you come to the campus.

- Continue to deep clean and disinfect all facilities using CDC approved sanitizers and disinfectants.
- Designated entry points will be established to reduce surface contact and promote physical distancing.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available at every designated entry and throughout the building.
- Following any gathering, all spaces and common areas will be sanitized and disinfected.
- Hallways have been cleared of furniture to allow for appropriate physical distancing.
- Continue excellent online worship to engage those who are not able to gather with us on campus.
- To minimize surface contact, continue to view our bulletin and weekly information online.
- Families and their guests are encouraged to sit and worship together. As part of our phased plan, Children and Student Sunday activities will resume at a later date.
- As part of our phased plan to return to on-campus worship, seating will be limited based on CDC recommendations.
